This is a dense and powerful wine which opens with an expansive bouquet of dark forest fruits and exotic spices with hints of leather and black pepper. On the palate, succulent berry fruits are supported by refreshing cassis flavours and polished tannins. Perfectly balanced with fine length, this is a wine for the long term. Drink from 2019.

About the producer

Founded in 1731 in Beaune by Michel Bouchard, Bouchard Père & Fils, is one of the oldest wine estates in Burgundy, perpetuating tradition for nearly 3 centuries and 9 generations. This desire to build up an exceptional estate in Côte d'Or endured through the generations and acquisitions in the best Villages were added throughout the 19th century and again in the early 20th century. Today the estate boasts 130 hectares of vines, of which 12 are classed Grand Cru and 74 classed as Premier Cru. Combining tradition and innovation, Bouchard Père & Fils works hard to bring out the distinctiveness of each successive vineyard and vintage, striving to make its wines exquisite works of art, each with its own personality and charm.
