

### VINTAGE REPORT

It is with great pleasure that we bring you the 2020 vintage from Burgundy. Our Master Sommelier, Nicolas Clerc, has been on the ground visiting our celebrated domaines. It was a poignant trip and a pleasure to be welcomed, in person, by so many friendly and familiar faces.

Twenty-twenty was a solar vintage characterised by drought and hot weather. For some, it was the earliest harvest on record, but thankfully one which yielded superb quality fruit with concentrated acids and sugars. The best wines are a joy to taste, offering the perfect balance between phenolic ripeness and refreshing acidity.

The whites are wonderfully precise, tense yet generous, and quality is very consistent across the board. The reds are deep in colour, with concentrated sugars, firm tannins and excellent structure, whilst also offering surprising freshness and tension. Tiny berries, a result of dehydration, affected yields more than the whites, and quantities are limited.

To see how the 2020 vintage began, we must return to 2019, with its mild autumn and winter. Notably, only seven days fell below freezing. This mild weather, the effect of climate change, continued into 2020. Flowering began at the end of April, which was unusually warm, and summer ushered in a warm ripening season. It became hot and sunny towards the end of June, and torrid weather continued throughout July and August.

Drought brings its own unique challenges and, perhaps surprisingly, opportunities. In particularly torrid conditions, there is the risk that vines shut down completely. In 2020,

however, dehydration had the welcome effect of concentrating both sugars and acidity (specifically, tartaric acid), a defining and unexpected character of the vintage.

The white wines stood out for their precision, tension and balance. As Sabine Mollard at Marc Morey in Chassagne-Montrachet told us: "It was a beautiful vintage, surprisingly fresh for a solar year. There is structure and tension. We feel that the vineyards have adapted to climate change." Several of our vignerons likened the character of the whites to 2017 and 2014, but with a touch more richness.

At Domaine de Montille, the fine balance of phenolic ripeness and tartaric acid was the key factor in producing top quality wines. As Chef de Cave Brian Sieve explains: "Harvest started on 21st August, with the wish to retain strong fruit character, concentrated acidity, and brightness and chalkiness - that fine line of phenolic ripeness. Dry conditions prevailed, which with the warm weather generated more tartaric acid... The whites are simply miraculous, superb!"

Domaine Bart in Marsannay and Jean-Luc and Eric Burguet in Gevrey-Chambertin noted the tiny size of the Pinot Noir berries. Sunshine thickens the grape skins, reducing the ratio of pulp to skin. For the reds, the resulting wines are rich, concentrated, deep in colour,

and boast a firm tannic structure. Yields were low, although perhaps not as low as initially expected. By August some terroirs saw sugars rising quickly, and for some domaines Pinot Noir was harvested before Chardonnay. Adapting quickly to the conditions was essential, and the challenge was to harvest before the sugar levels were too high, whilst ensuring that skins and pips had ripened fully – all whilst retaining that all-important acidity.

Christophe Roumier pointed out the high diurnal range (the difference in temperature between warm days and cool nights), which helps retain acidity: "We are happy and surprised at the high level of quality. It was a solar vintage, with high temperatures. It was a little crop, 30% down. The diurnal range helped a lot. It was the same approach for us as in 2012."

In conclusion, twenty-twenty has yielded many superb wines. For the time being, the vintage defines itself as a stunning white vintage, with tension and precision balanced by generosity. Many will be delicious in their youth, especially across the Bourgogne and Village appellations.

For the delicious, beautifully-balanced reds, with their concentrated sugars, deep colour and firm tannins, time will tell how they develop in the bottle. We look forward to revisiting them. Tiny berries, a consequence

of dehydration, mean that volumes will be down. We suspect pricing will also be a cause for discussion, especially given that the low volumes across the board for the 2021 vintage is at the forefront of our producers' minds.

The great domaines will always be highly sought-after, which is why we are always on the look-out for young, artisanal talent. This year we are delighted to welcome Jean-Baptiste Jessiaume to our offering. We also welcome the much-anticipated return of Domaine Darviot-Perrin. The wines are, quite simply, stunning, and amongst the finest whites we tasted.

It is rewarding to follow the ever-increasing quality of wines from Domaine Bart in Marsannay, Domaine Thomas Collardot in Puligny-Montrachet, Jean-Luc & Eric Burguet in Gevrey-Chambertin, Domaine Michel Mallard in Ladoix, and Domaine Rebourgeon-Mure in Pommard. Amongst these producers you will find some of the best value wines for your money in all of Burgundy, and we strongly encourage you to discover their quality for yourself.

## DOMAINE AGNÈS, DIDIER ET FLORENT DAUVISSAT

The most recent of the Dauvissat domaines in Chablis, Domaine Agnès and Didier Dauvissat released its first vintage in 1989. It now stretches over 10 ha, with parcels in Petit Chablis, Chablis village and the premier cru Beauroy. Florent, their son, is now at the helm of the property, crafting vibrant, zesty and distinctly mineral Chablis. Despite being a relatively new producer, Domaine Agnès and Didier Dauvissat is already making a name for itself with their pure expressions of Chardonnay.

## DOMAINE WILLIAM FÈVRE

William Fèvre has become the benchmark for classic Chablis. Since William founded his domaine in 1959, some of the most sought-after vineyards have been added to the portfolio which now totals 78 ha including 5 of the 7 Grands Crus. No other producer can claim such an array of the finest vineyards in Chablis. The Premiers Crus see 30% to 40% maturation in barrel while the Grands Crus have 40% to 50%, both in old wood.

"It was the hottest vintage of the century. We had warm winter, early budding, healthy flowering but with some millerandage. Vines suffered toward the end of August. Strong northern winds started to split berries. We harvested on 18th August. Unusually, we harvested the Pinot before the Chardonnay. There was a lack of potassium because of no rain before the harvest, which preserved the tartaric acid."

### JEAN-BAPTISTE JESSIAUME

We are pleased to welcome Jean-Baptiste Jessiaume to our selection. Based in Santenay, the estate comprises 9 ha of vines. Jean Baptiste comes from a long family line intimately involved in wine stretching back over 200 years. Initially, the Jessiaumes were merchants and accountants in the 18th century and offered a selection of fine wines from the neighboring communes in the southern Côte de Beaune. In 1830, the family acquired vineyards and became vignerons outright with substantial parcels located around Santenay. This continued until 2007 when the Jean Baptiste's father and uncle relinquished the vines. If Jean Baptiste had already been steeped in viticulture and wine making (collecting the Young Burgundian Winemaker of the Year in 2012 at the age of 23), his teenage years were spent in other verdant fields: football pitches. Common sense prevailed and he returned to his roots in Santenay. After a stint as head winemaker for a large Côte Chalonnaise Domaine, he finally set up his own business in 2019 and the selection closely echoes the offerings of his forebears 200 years ago. These are beautifully terroir-expressive wines and not to be missed.

### BENJAMIN LEROUX

A dynamic and extremely talented winemaker, Benjamin Leroux made a name for himself at Domaine du Comte Armand where he was the general manager until 2014. Based in Beaune, he launched his own label in 2007, so did two jobs at once for some years' to 'Based in Beaune, he launched his own label in 2007, doing two jobs at once for some years. Wines are produced from over 20 vineyards but this remains very much a micro-winery. Apart from 8.3 ha owned by the Domaine, grapes are purchased from trusted growers, most of whom are either organic or biodynamic. In 2017, he took on the running of 2.5 ha in Meursault Blagny.

"Ren was keen to stress that 2020 was not a hot year, but a very, very dry one; a luminous vintage but not "solaire" (hot sun). Equally important was the diurnal fluctuation. There were a couple of occasions when the thermometer hit 40 degrees, but the nights were between 15-20 degrees, which helped to keep the humidity in the vineyards. He started his harvest with his early vineyards in the Côte de Beaune on 20th August. Ben feels that the Chardonnay coped well and provided a normal juice to solids ratio. The skins of the Pinot Noir became very thick; whereas a normal yield would be 1/3 solids to 2/3 juice, this year the red mix was nearer to 50/50. As a result, yields for the reds were down, as much as 50% in the Côte de Beaune. Harvest in the Côte de Nuits began on 25th August."

Once again it matches the 2018 and 2019, once again it leans in style towards the Grands Crus or perhaps just remains true to its own, slightly aloof beauty. Here the nose is restrained, subtly rich, layered and with an almost atmospheric minerality but with a power of perfume that continues even as you run out of breath. The palate is also subtly rich, with a dry, firm structure, super refined fruit and an insinuating flare of intensity on the finish. Beautiful wine.






## DOMAINE LAFARGE

Domaine Lafarge has around 10 ha in some of the best plots in Volnay. Frédéric Lafarge joined in 1978 and 2018 is the first vintage he made with his daughter Clothilde. Like his late father Michel, Frédéric is warm and sincere with a deep connection to the land. They believe passionately that the vineyard is the secret to success. Biodynamic principles are followed and the wines are allowed to express the individual characters of each terroir. In the cellar, the wines are gently handled, oak ageing is kept to a minimum and there is virtually no filtration. It seems hardly anything has changed and yet Frédéric has recently introduced innovations including manual destemming for some cuvées and the reintroduction of a basket press. Tasting in Lafarge's ancient cellar amongst the cobwebs is a transporting experience.

Philippe Colin, in Chassagne-Montrachet, produces outstanding wines over 13 ha. The Domaine was established in 2004, when Philippe split from his brother Bruno and built his own cellar on the outskirts of the village. He has an impressive selection of vineyards, including some Chevalier-Montrachet, and makes wines which can be enjoyed after a few years but his top cuvées require ageing. He adopts a philosophy of minimal intervention in the vineyards. Since 2010, he has been experimenting with large barrels (demi-muids) to provide better wood integration. The village wines are matured in 20% to 25% new oak and the Premiers Crus have around 35% new oak. These delightful wines combine power with elegance and offer much pleasure.

"Harvest started under a beautiful sun on 22nd August, one day earlier than in 2003, the earliest in our history. It was a very interesting vintage but with 50% less in terms of yields. The wines are absolutely beautiful and shining. We have focused particularly on the ageing and the quality of the oak we are using, becoming more meticulous with regards to provenance. The results bring greater precision to the aromas, without the wood dominating. We are still working on our organic certification, which the 2021 vintage challenged, but that will be the matter for the next release."

### DOMAINE THOMAS COLLARDOT

Bubbly, endearing Jacqueline Collardot couldn't resist the call of tradition when her father retired from the family Domaine. First, however, she had to obtain her diploma at the "viti" in Beaune before taking over the 2.5 hectares in 2011. There are worse places to own vines than Puligny-Montrachet and the estate boasts a mouthwatering range of village wines and two premiers crus. The emphasis will remain on showcasing terroir through offerings of single vineyard wines. The first vintage Jacqueline made from A to Z was 2015 and the vines were tended on a sustainable model although the aim is to convert to organic farming as soon as possible. All the vineyard work is either done by hand or horse depending on the parcel. Fermentation occurs with natural wild yeasts. The wines are pressed gently and slowly, settling then fermentation and elevage in barrel for 10 month. Barrels are then blended in stainless steel tank for three months before bottling occurs. The premier crus are to be found in Hameau de Blagny and a prime chunk of racy Folatières. In 2018, her son Mathieu decided to pack in his job as a website developer and join forces.


