Once past the gloriously complex aromatics (blueberries, black currants, minerals, and underbrush), the wine reveals terrific fruit intensity, excellent harmony, medium body, sweet tannin, and a long finish". About the producer

Château Ducru-Beaucaillou began in 1720, owing its name to the large pebbles that characterise the terroir and offer exceptional wine-making conditions. Its wines boast finesse and elegance and it is one of the only castles in Bordeaux to be built over its cellars, producing a 'grand cru classé' still inhabited by its owners.

Its immediate proximity to the Gironde estuary plays a key role in the microclimate of this vineyard where the huge amount of water moved by the tides four times a day act as air conditioners, providing heat in winter and coolness in summer. This creates a temperate climate, sparing vineyards from the ravages of frost and hailstorms.
