Tasting notes

The aromas struggling to break free from the flute eventually emerge as intense rich bouquets of peaches and red apples accompanied by hints of toast and undertones of earth. Whilst still very young and tightly wound, there are clues of what else is to come. This is robust and rich and we can only expect the flavours to expand and become more complex with some bottle age. The palate reaffirms the nose with dense flavours and layers of apples, pears, peaches and white flowers. The sophisticated addition of autolytic aromas is confirmed by notes of cream, mushrooms and brioche that add to the mouthfeel as the length of the wine keeps the mind wandering for minutes. The 2004 Cuvée Sir Winston Churchill is everything you would expect, however still very tight on the palate and it will certainly fill out with time, giving the taster an unforgettable experience in a few years time.

About the producer

Recently we were delighted to receive a sample bottle of the 2004 Pol Roger Cuvée Sir Winston Churchill. Anxiously, we waited (with salivating mouths) for the wine to chill to the correct serving temperature before we could open and taste it and then... Wow! Boy, was it worth the wait!

Tightly wound, there is a nervous energy about it. It needs a few years of cellaring before showing its true potential and complexity. This is a wine where the Pinot Noir fruit shows the intricacies that can be achieved with intense earthy notes currently held together with searing acidity.
