### Tasting notes

The Shiraz grapes for this ESP 'reserve cuvee' were sourced mainly from vines planted on the Estate during the 1930s. Heady notes of spice and blackberries on the nose, leading to more black fruits, cherries and bacon rind on the palate with herby and earthy notes. Powerful and brooding, this has excellent fruit concentration and complexity, good grainy tannins and a very long finish.

### About the producer

With vines dating back to 1860, Tahbilk is one of the oldest established wineries in Australia. Based in a lakeland area of Victoria, which cools the climate somewhat, this terroir is ideal for the grapes of the Northern Côtes du Rhône - particularly white Marsanne and red Syrah/Shiraz.
