The baby Grand Cru, showing the silkiness and finesse of a top vineyard. This is a distinctive, overtly mineral wine with a lovely balance and sense of presence. Once again, this is one of the best value wines in the range. Drink 2008-2018.

About the producer

Joseph Henriot purchased this fabulous but underperforming domaine in 1998 and the results have been nothing short of dramatic. In a mere ten years, Fèvre has gone to the top of the premier league, re-establishing a style that with its minerality, purity and lip-smacking acidity is right in line with what great Chablis should be all about. The problem on the horizon though is supply as everybody wants these wines all around the world and the days of top Chablis selling at a huge discount to the Côte d'Or may be numbered. With Didier Seguié at the helm, the future at Fèvre appears very bright and with the 2009s just released, we have another set of beautiful wines to thrill loyal fans and recent converts alike.
