Tasting notes

Deep colour and a tight, mineral nose. Broad, mineral and tannic start in the mouth, there is real density and intense black fruits here which evolve as the wine warms up. Lots of glycerol and mineral intensity - concentrated and powerful, yet supple and refined. Long, long fruit/mineral finish - really fine wine. Drink from 2013.

About the producer

Franck Follin is another quiet, unassuming character whose wines do all the talking. The vineyards of the hill of Corton may boast some of the most famous names of the region but Franck is as likely to enthuse about his Pernand 1er Cru as his Corton Charlemagne. His is a deep and genuine passion for this undervalued section of the Côte and his ability to bring finesse and elegance to these wines alongside their natural structure and stature makes them popular with all those who seek beauty alongside form.
