Deep red-ruby. Pure, perfumed aromas of redcurrant, plum and Oriental spices. Richer and sweeter than the Grands-Echezeaux, with the exotic spice character following through in the mouth. Finishes firm, long and aromatic, with lingering oak spice and captivating minerality. Our RSV always takes a couple days longer to ferment than our other wines, noted Noblet. - 92-94 points Stephen Tanzer
