Tasting notes

Subtle cassis notes alongside floral perfumes point to an elegant Lafite with more finesse than power. The textures are very silky, with the tannins beautifully handled. Purity and classicism on the palate but certainly not exuberance, as today this is rather introverted. The wine flows easily in a rather lithe manner with excellent persistence on the finish. Not the usual density this year and certainly a mid-term Lafite in the vein of the delicious 1999. - 17.5 points

About the producer

Lafite has had a complicated history since its first recorded reference in 1234. In 1868, the Rothschild family acquired the property. Aside from a period during the second world war when the property was requisitioned and put into public administration, the property has remained with the Rothschild family ever since. Today under the direction of Eric de Rothschild, Lafite has an unrivalled reputation the world over. The unique terroir of the 178 hectares in the north of Pauillac, the largest of the premiers crus, has contributed to a series of outstanding vintages over the last decade.
