100% Sangiovese aged in traditional, medium sized oak barrels for 12 months, Monteleccio always stands out with its immediate charm, abundant fruit and smooth tannins. 2007 doesn't disappoint either: the wine instantly offers a bouquet of dark red fruits and sweet spices with a supportive core of soft and silky tannins. Amazing value and the perfect all rounder.

About the producer

Sesti are one of the most delightfully individual producers in Armit's portfolio. Giuseppe Maria Sesti and his daughter Elisa hold just 13 hectares of vines in a unique micro-climate in southern Montalcino, Sesti produces elegant Sangiovese with a distinct floral note. Self-described as "eclectic by nature", Giuseppe ran a Baroque Opera festival for thirty years while restoring the medieval the Castello di Argiano, which features on their labels, and developing the vineyards. Having written no fewer than five books on astronomy, Giuseppe considers the influence of the moon indispensable to viticulture and Sesti makes wine according to biodynamic practices.
