Tasting notes

In contrast to the Meursault, this is a far more mineral wine with greater acidity and a long, fresh vital feel. On the palate, there is already the hint of considerable complexity and potential and this looks certain to be the most successful vintage of this relatively new addition to the cellar seen to date. Drink from 2012.

About the producer

One of the legendary estates in Volnay, Domaine Lafarge has been crafting understated and pure expressions of Pinot Noir for decades. Committed vignerons Michel Lafarge and his son Frederic tend to 11.6 ha of vines in Volnay and Beaune. The range is a dazzling collection of terroir-driven Burgundy's which are incredibly traditional in style. Little new oak is used in the winery allowing the purity of the fruit to shine through, giving wines of exceptional purity, focus and energy.
