Tasting notes

Sesti's 2008 Brunello di Montalcino is heady with strawberry, cherry and pot-pourri. Mint and spices combine on the palate to create a dense texture alongside classic tea leaves and balsam. This is a complex Brunello which is elegant and attractive, unravelling in the mouth and leading to a lifted, graceful finish. Top quality Brunello from this exceptional estate.

About the producer

Sesti are one of the most delightfully individual producers in Armit's portfolio. Giuseppe Maria Sesti and his daughter Elisa hold just 13 hectares of vines in a unique micro-climate in southern Montalcino, Sesti produces elegant Sangiovese with a distinct floral note. Self-described as "eclectic by nature", Giuseppe ran a Baroque Opera festival for thirty years while restoring the medieval the Castello di Argiano, which features on their labels, and developing the vineyards. Having written no fewer than five books on astronomy, Giuseppe considers the influence of the moon indispensable to viticulture and Sesti makes wine according to biodynamic practices.
