Tasting notes

Grown on very steep, south-facing slopes, this is classic Chablis with pure almost sweet fruit flavours and a bracing, mineral intensity. The cuvée may not be as well known as Valmur or Les Clos but it suffers nothing by comparison and is often one of the finest in the Fèvre line up. The 2008 is a particular success. Drink 2014-2020+.

About the producer

Joseph Henriot purchased this fabulous but underperforming domaine in 1998 and the results have been nothing short of dramatic. In a mere ten years, Fèvre has gone to the top of the premier league, re-establishing a style that with its minerality, purity and lip-smacking acidity is right in line with what great Chablis should be all about. The problem on the horizon though is supply as everybody wants these wines all around the world and the days of top Chablis selling at a huge discount to the Côte d'Or may be numbered. With Didier Seguier at the helm, the future at Fèvre appears very bright and with the 2009s just released, we have another set of beautiful wines to thrill loyal fans and recent converts alike.
