Tasting notes

A fascinating wine which engages and demands your attention, this begins with gamey, wild fruit notes but progresses in a surprisingly flighty manner across the palate, despite the structured presence of tannins that immediately point to the wine's origins. There is an energy and vigour here rarely seen in this vineyard which gives it tremendous appeal. However, there is never any escaping the seriousness of this wine either which undoubtedly pleads to be given a little time to develop further. Drink from 2015.

About the producer

With a Domaine that was established at the end of the 18th century, Etienne Grivot has often felt the weight of history when he joined his father Jean in 1982. 1993 marked a turning point and since then the trajectory of Domaine Grivot has been nothing but upwards. Today, a more mellowed and confident Etienne is one of the most respected figures in the region, producing wines of purity, freshness and precision year-in, year-out.
