About the producer

Located thirteen kilometers from Bordeaux on the right bank of the Garonne river lies the estate, which is part of the family wine-farm Château Haut-Calens. In the 1970s new owner Albert Yung reconstructed the vineyard and cellars, which were re-built in a modern way to produce the highest quality wine possible from the estate. Renowned for a delicate texture, elegance and full body this is a brand renowned as a top wine.
