Aromas of bright floral red berries, minerals and fresh herbs lead on to a plush, multi-layered palate with fine, polished tannins. Attractive chewy tannins provide backbone to the crisp flavours before a long clean finish that features a very strong savory quality. Gorgeous, tangy and deep-fruited. A tremendous wine.

Sesti are one of the most delightfully individual producers in Armit's portfolio. Giuseppe Maria Sesti and his daughter Elisa hold just 13 hectares of vines in a unique micro-climate in southern Montalcino. Sesti produces elegant Sangiovese with a distinct floral note. Self-described as "eclectic by nature", Giuseppe ran a Baroque Opera festival for thirty years while restoring the medieval the Castello di Argiano, which features on their labels, and developing the vineyards. Having written no fewer than five books on astronomy, Giuseppe considers the influence of the moon indispensable to viticulture and Sesti makes wine according to biodynamic practices.
