### Tasting notes

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Juicy fruits and a breezy, lifted style on the nose, on the palate there is natural balance and ripe, fine tannins. This is easy and classic in the best sense of the word, a good middle-weight that is impossible to dislike. This shows admirable precision and is excellent value. Drink 2015-2025. 16

### About the producer

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Château Calon Segur from the Saint-Estèphe appellation in Bordeaux is one of the fourteen classified third growths in the famous Bordeaux classification of 1855. It is one of the original three vineyards in Saint-Estèphe and is a historic estate once housing the famous Château Montrose in 1825. It is also the northern most classified growth in the Médoc.

Former owner Nicolas-Alexandre, marquis de Ségur who also controlled Château Latour and Château Lafite at the time, once claimed that his “heart was with Calon” leading to the modern day label to contain a heart shaped around the name of the wine. The estate has been owned by the Capbern Gasqueton family since 1894. The wines of Château Calon Segur have been cited of falling between Cos d’Estournel and Montrose in style, being long lived without aggression.
