Tasting notes

A prized parcel in the sub-plot Aux Perrières, shared with Coche Dury, this is a classic Meursault from vines planted in 1937 which give tiny little berries. The notes are floral and white fruit-dominated with a fine interplay between the aromatic elements. On the palate, the wine turns sharply towards minerality, with a strong vibrant seam running through the wine which is carried through onto the long finish. Beautifully judged, top quality Meursault.

About the producer

Didier Darviot likes to work at his own pace - his sites often see him harvesting later, his cold cellar always mean particularly slow malolactic fermentation and inevitably, his wines are shipped right at the end! However, good things come to those who wait and it is undeniable that this quiet, unassuming couple are producing some of the most exciting Meursault in the village. We also adore the Volnay Les Blanchés, a vineyard that can be unforgiving, but in Darviot's hands, it finds a warmth and soul.
