Tasting notes

Deux Montille's Poruzot is a beauty in this vintage, packed full of pear, green and red apple with a lifted floral elegance. 2009 was a warm vintage but this Poruzot is all about acidity and poise. A hint of buttery, toasty notes on the mid-palate with fine, persistent apple and stone fruit flavours continuing onto the finish. A beautifully poised wine that will start drinking well now but has at least a decade ahead of it.

About the producer

One of the great estates in Burgundy, Domaine de Montille produces incredibly elegant and understated wines. Established by Hubert de Montille, who inherited a few Volnay vines in 1951, the estate now comprises 17 ha. The wines had a reputation for requiring a long time to reach maturity but under Étienne de Montille, with the help of Chef de Cave Brian Sieve, the aromatic complexity of the wines has been brought to the fore.
