## **Tasting notes**

The Estate Cabernet is produced using traditional winemaking techniques, fermenting the juice in open oak vats then maturing the wine in large French oak barrels for 18 months prior to bottling. Rich scents of chocolate, blackberries and plums on the nose with velvety smooth juicy fruit flavours of black cherries, redcurrants and more blackberries on the palate with herbal notes and a touch of mint on the finish. Good chewy tannins and long length on the finish.

## About the producer

With vines dating back to 1860, Tahbilk is one of the oldest established wineries in Australia. Based in a lakeland area of Victoria, which cools the climate somewhat, this terroir is ideal for the grapes of the Northern Côtes du Rhône - particularly white Marsanne and red Syrah/Shiraz.
