Digby Fine English is quite literally the gold standard for English sparkling wine. Every year all four of Digby's wines rake in medals, awards, and accolades, helping to cement the winery's reputation as one of England's very finest sparkling. This is driven by their obsession with terroir: from the outset, Digby focused on securing the best fruit from plots across the south of England, rather than the vineyards they could buy. A special balance of chalk, greensand, and clay sites across Dorset, Sussex, Hampshire, and Kent, are drawn out with low-intervention winemaking and long lees-ageing. Digby plans to continue winning awards and topping charts for many years to come, and shows a deep commitment to sustainability and is Net Zero carbon emissions!
