Tasting notes

This majority Carignan blend is bursting with mixed berries, plums and roasted figs on the nose. Incredibly well balanced, with sweet fruit flavours underpinned by black fruit and refreshing acidity, this is a deliciously complex wine. Liquorice flavours intermingle with notes of strawberry and blackberry compote which dance on the palate. The lengthy finish is characterised by ripe plum flavours supported by fine, silky tannins. This is a beautiful expression of Carignan from Château Maris.

About the producer

Château Maris has been named “one of the five most environmentally-friendly wineries in the world” by WineSpectator and a “Sustainability hero” by Jancis Robinson MW. It was the first European vineyard to receive the B Corporation certification, a label recognized by the UN and European Commission – a certification held by just 27 wineries worldwide today. Maris boasts a world-first carbon-negative winery constructed from hemp bricks, while the vineyards are hand-harvested and tilled by a horse-drawn plough. Sales of their wine support local wildlife and biodiversity initiatives such as L’Aspas and La Masion de L’Abeille, and they even made headlines for shipping wine to the USA by sailboat!
