### Tasting notes

A delicate wine on the nose with notes of violets, subtle red fruits and a hint of pepper and spice. The palate is slightly reserved at the moment but there is a lot of hidden depth supported by a fine backbone of tannins and an energetic freshness. This wine will need a few years in bottle before it reaches full expression.

### About the producer

---

In 1997 Jean-Marc Millot took control of his own domaine after many years of battling with members of his own family but it has taken a further decade to get to the level that he wants to be at. Tasting his 2006s with him in autumn 2007 was a revelation and we quickly acted to secure an allocation. His style favours fruit-driven, fresh wines over wines of power and force. His gorgeous 2007s more than justified our faith in his abilities and his wines have quickly become a well-kept secret amongst those who have discovered them but don't wish to let the cat out of the bag!
