## Tasting notes

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Powerful citrus characters on the nose with aromatic floral notes. The palate is bursting with sweet, ripe citrus fruits balanced by a refreshing lemon and lime character. On the finish a mineral, woody note adds to the complexity. Drink from 2014.

## About the producer

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Mischief & Mayhem was founded in 2004 as a partnership between two old friends from opposite ends of the globe, borne out of a recognition of the region's ability to bring frustration and elation to the consumer in equal measure.

The dynamic duo of Englishman Michael Ragg and Australian Michael Twelftree have a substantial background in the world of wine, where the former worked for a decade in the London wine trade before taking up residency with Aloxe-Corton. The latter is the driving force behind the hugely successful Barossa Valley-based wines of Two Hands.

With Ragg's first-hand knowledge of the region and experience of its wines and Twelftree's passion for wine and knowledge of international markets, Mischief & Mayhem has two gifted and ambitious creative forces behind it.

Rather than attempt to build a domaine by buying land, Mischief & Mayhem sources its fruit and juice from a variety of growers with whom they have built close relationships. This gives the flexibility to only work with fruit that comes up to their strict quality standards rather than being forced to produce wines from substandard grapes due to the obligation of owning the land from which the grapes were grown. The range generally extends from Grand Cru to generics but is always fashioned in a style that encourages early drinking as well as the option for further cellaring.

Time and again, when we put these wines in customer's glasses, they come back for more.
