Tasting notes

Very elegant wine, the nose is gentle and delicate with a wonderful limey zing. The palate has plenty of crab apples, greengages, freshly squeezed lime juice and chalky, oyster shell minerality. This wine is packed full of promise, it is very youthful at the moment but 'boy oh boy' this will be a great wine given a bit of time. The concentration, acidity, fruit and structure are all in perfect harmony; enjoy after 3 years or so in the cellar.

About the producer

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the south-east of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sebastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closing with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis – mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
