Tasting notes

This Sauvignon Blanc displays tropical and citrus aromas framed by a fresh acidity and underpinned by a chalky mineral complexity. The palate is finely textured with gooseberry, subtly lychee and mineral flavours leading to a persistent finish. This wine is drinking well now but will develop well over the next five years.

About the producer

Inspired by Michael Seresin's own connections and interests, the Seresin Estate are a new world winery with an old world approach - they are in no hurry when it comes to their wines. They let the wild yeasts that live in their vineyard ferment the grape juice into wine. Working this way takes a little more time, but achieves wines with added savouriness and with more mouth watering textures and flavours. They also show a unique sense of place. Seresin Estate let all their wines spend time in barrel or bottle before release. It's true what they say, good things come to those who wait.
