### Tasting notes

The Estate Shiraz is produced using traditional winemaking techniques, fermenting the juice in open oak vats then maturing the wine in large French oak barrels for 18 months prior to bottling. Red and black fruits aromas intermingle with spice on the nose, leading onto a palate rich with ripe, juicy black and red fruit flavours, with notes of cedar, pepper and clove spice. A supple mouthfeel with good grainy tannins to lend structure.

### About the producer

With vines dating back to 1860, Tahbilk is one of the oldest established wineries in Australia. Based in a lakeland area of Victoria, which cools the climate somewhat, this terroir is ideal for the grapes of the Northern Côtes du Rhône - particularly white Marsanne and red Syrah/Shiraz.
