### Tasting notes

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Vin de Paille is the region's 'straw wine.' A wine made by concentrating the grapes (Chardonnay, Savagnin and Poulsard) on straw mats to raisins concentrating the flavours. It takes 100 kilograms of grapes to produce just 10 litres of Vin de Paille meaning the wine is very limited. Flavours are rich and concentrated with a flavour spectrum from honey and toasted almonds to lemon rind and baked apple.

### About the producer

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Nicole Deriaux runs this family estate of 8 hectares located in the south west of Jura in the town of L'Etoile. L'Etoile is also the name of the small appellation to which the AOC status was given in 1937 in recognition the wine's great finesse and elegance. It is said that the name for the town L'Etoile, French for star, is given to it because of the five hills surrounding the town in the pattern of a star or perhaps because of the presence of numerous starfish fossils in the soils.
