Tasting notes

Once again the nose is charmed by the elegant, sweet aromas of morello cherries and raspberries. The finesse of Nebbiolo! The palate is a soft dance of red fruits and tannins, reaching towards a long finish. Certainly a wine where age will take it to new heights but equally one to enjoy now.

About the producer

When Claudio Fenocchio succeeded his father Giacomo at the helm of the family business in 1989, the debate between modernist and traditionalists in Barolo was at its most acute. He decided to opt for a third approach, something we can call radical traditionalism. His wines were celebrated for being impressively approachable in youth while getting even better with age. Claudio represents the 5th generation of the Fenocchio family crafting elegant, true Barolos that capture the soul of his vineyards. Far from resting on his laurels though, he continues to push boundaries of quality and innovation while respecting his family legacy.
