This is a breathtaking white from Lafarge and an excellent example of how good Beaune Blanc can be in the right hands. The clean, pure nose of crisp lemon and apple notes framed by a deep minerality tees up a fantastic palate. The interplay between the medium-bodied structure, crisp citrus acidity and green apple fruit proves captivating and the level of complexity is a marvel to behold! This is a truly exceptional white. One of the legendary estates in Volnay, Domaine Lafarge has been crafting understated and pure expressions of Pinot Noir for decades. Committed vignerons Michel Lafarge and his son Frederic tend to 11.6 ha of vines in Volnay and Beaune. The range is a dazzling collection of terroir-driven Burgundy's which are incredibly traditional in style. Little new oak is used in the winery allowing the purity of the fruit to shine through, giving wines of exceptional purity, focus and energy.
