### Tasting notes

This is a breathtaking white from Lafarge and an excellent example of how good Beaune Blanc can be in the right hands. The clean, pure nose of crisp lemon and apple notes framed by a deep minerality tees up a fantastic palate. The interplay between the medium-bodied structure, crisp citrus acidity and green apple fruit proves captivating and the level of complexity is a marvel to behold! This is a truly exceptional white. Drink from 2013.

### About the producer

Domaine Lafarge dates back to the Revolution and beyond. Over a great many years, this has been the source of some of the most consistently fine wines in the Côte de Beaune and they are never flippant wines for casual, premature acquaintance, a good 10 years for anything at village level or above will be no problem at all. The Lafarges are still committed vignerons who are in the vines every day and who totally believe that the quality of the fruit is the secret to great wine. The vines are treated with great care allowing the nuances of the terroir to speak out. The next twenty years at the Domaine will doubtless pass like the last twenty years, producing understated, classic wines of benchmark quality.
