## **Tasting notes**

There is composure and calm here as the wine opens with a glimpse of white peach and pear notes. Slowly the nose builds in intensity, offering a little aniseed, counterbalanced by a soft buttery note. This is a wine that you have to go to but each investigation gives a new element to consider. There is a fine thread running through the wine, excellent depth from the old vines and extra length that truly shows the quality. A very great Bienvenues from a vineyard on a fine run of form. Drink from 2018.

## About the producer

The vision of Anne-Claude Leflaive in the 1990s took this Puligny Montrachet Domaine to the heights of white wine production, not only in Burgundy but in the rest of the world. Today, her nephew Brice de La Morandière - who has had a successful career running multinational companies - continues her philosophy of organic, biodynamic viticulture, bringing Chardonnay grapes to their best possible expression in Grand Cru and Premier Cru climates, where the terroir has been restored to health by natural practices.
