Tasting notes

This juicy wine has a beautiful cherry red colour. The nose shows an abundance of intense red berry fruit and hints of vanilla flavours. The palate is soft, full flavoured with a smooth easy drinking finish. This cuvee is an ideal partner to any meat dishes, roasted vegetables or cheeses. It is very easy to pair.

About the producer

After the Vin de Pays classification of 1979, the cultivation of new grape varieties in the region led to an increasing number of white wines from Languedoc. It is traditionally a territory known for its red wine, but locally produced rosé and white wines have seen a growth in popularity and demand in recent years.
