Tasting notes

This is a substantial, mouth-filling wine, showing the generosity of the vineyard but also its undeniable charm. The nose is floral with a gentle grapefruit perfume behind it, on the palate, citrus dominates before hinting at rocks and struck-match towards the finish. This is an infant at this stage but there is so much going on here that it will no doubt grow up to be a fascinating adult. Drink from 2016.

About the producer

One of the great estates in Burgundy, Domaine de Montille produces incredibly elegant and understated wines. Established by Hubert de Montille, who inherited a few Volnay vines in 1951, the estate now comprises 17 ha. The wines had a reputation for requiring a long time to reach maturity but under Étienne de Montille, with the help of Chef de Cave Brian Sieve, the aromatic complexity of the wines has been brought to the fore.
