### Tasting notes

A classic Chablis to be drunk fresh and young. Lively citrus and green apple aromas with a delicate mineral note are followed by refreshing flavours of lemon and lime with hints of toast and honey and a delicious, mouthwatering acidity. Sébastien Dampt's 2011 vintage will be a beautiful accompaniment to all types of fish and shellfish. While made to be drunk now, this Chablis will be at its best until 2014.

### About the producer

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the south-east of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sébastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closing with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis – mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
