### Tasting notes

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Chassagne Montrachet wines are generally superb in 2011. Blain's Caillerets is a very detailed, subtle wine with elegant, acacia flower aromas and hints of exotic white pepper. The palate has a lovely persistence with delicate stone fruit characters and a racy acidity which runs through to the finish. This wine could be drunk young but allow it to mature for another 3 or 4 years to get the most from it. Drink from 2015.

### About the producer

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One of the producers that expresses more than others the spirit of Chassagne Montrachet. With pure, elegant wines that are always approachable in youth but have an incredible capacity of ageing and developing in the cellar for decades. Jean-Marc and Claudine Blain consistently produce some exemplary wines at village level and release some of the most sought-after Grand Crus from their tiny holdings of Caillerets.
