Tasting notes

This is very complex with a delicate, almost ethereal bouquet of lively, pure red berry fruits with dark raspberry notes and a refined mineral quality in the background. The tannins are polished and integrated and balance the delicate, smooth red fruit flavours. This is fluid and energetic and will continue to develop in complexity. Drink from 2016.

About the producer

In 1997 Jean-Marc Millot took control of his own domaine after many years of battling with members of his own family but it has taken a further decade to get to the level that he wants to be at. Tasting his 2006s with him in autumn 2007 was a revelation and we quickly acted to secure an allocation. His style favours fruit-driven, fresh wines over wines of power and force. His gorgeous 2007s more than justified our faith in his abilities and his wines have quickly become a well-kept secret amongst those who have discovered them but don't wish to let the cat out of the bag!
