Pale yellow in colour with enticing floral and tropical fruit aromas. Ripe and tangy fruit flavours of green apples, zesty citrus and peach on the palate with hints of spice and a creamy texture. Zippy acidity to balance with good length. Excellent value.

### About the producer

When Claudio Fenocchio succeeded his father Giacomo at the helm of the family business in 1989, the debate between modernist and traditionalists in Barolo was at its most acute. He decided to opt for a third approach, something we can call radical traditionalism. His wines were celebrated for being impressively approachable in youth while getting even better with age. Claudio represents the 5th generation of the Fenocchio family crafting elegant, true Barolos that capture the soul of his vineyards. Far from resting on his laurels though, he continues to push boundaries of quality and innovation while respecting his family legacy.
