Tasting notes

Always a very aromatic and attractive wine, the 2012 has more weight than the previous vintage with a long mineral finish. On the nose, delicate raspberry and redcurrant notes play over darker savoury and exotic spice characters. The palate is flowing and energetic showing succulent tannins with hints of sweet herbs and lavender. Although it will be delicious in a few years it has the capacity to age for a long time. Drink from 2016.

About the producer

Founded in 1731 in Beaune by Michel Bouchard, Bouchard Père & Fils $_7$ is one of the oldest wine estates in Burgundy, perpetuating tradition for nearly 3 centuries and 9 generations. This desire to build up an exceptional estate in Côte d'Or endured through the generations and acquisitions in the best Villages were added throughout the 19th century and again in the early 20th century. Today the estate boasts 130 hectares of vines, of which 12 are classed Grand Cru and 74 classed as Premier Cru. Combining tradition and innovation, Bouchard Père & Fils works hard to bring out the distinctiveness of each successive vineyard and vintage, striving to make its wines exquisite works of art, each with its own personality and charm.
