Tasting notes

Due to very low yields in the Aigrots and Grèves vineyards, Lafarge decided to blend the two vineyards together to make one Beaune 1er Cru, a wine which combines the classic depth and elegance of the Grèves with the complexity and verve of the Aigrots. The wine displays a lovely inviting nose of concentrated berries with a lovely elegant floral lift. On the palate, the wine has layers of juicy fruit backed by a good structure and well integrated acidity. A very impressive result. Drink from 2015.

About the producer

One of the legendary estates in Volnay, Domaine Lafarge has been crafting understated and pure expressions of Pinot Noir for decades. Committed vignerons Michel Lafarge and his son Frederic tend to 11.6 ha of vines in Volnay and Beaune. The range is a dazzling collection of terroir-driven Burgundy's which are incredibly traditional in style. Little new oak is used in the winery allowing the purity of the fruit to shine through, giving wines of exceptional purity, focus and energy.
