### Tasting notes

This is a breathtaking white Beaune from Lafarge with a very clean, pure nose of crisp lemon and apple notes framed by a deep minerality and the lift of white flowers. The balance between the structure, crisp citrus acidity and green apple fruit reveals a wine that is inviting and approachable with an astonishing level of complexity. Drink from 2015.

### About the producer

One of the legendary estates in Volnay, Domaine Lafarge has been crafting understated and pure expressions of Pinot Noir for decades. Committed vignerons Michel Lafarge and his son Frederic tend to 11.6 ha of vines in Volnay and Beaune. The range is a dazzling collection of terroir-driven Burgundy's which are incredibly traditional in style. Little new oak is used in the winery allowing the purity of the fruit to shine through, giving wines of exceptional purity, focus and energy.
