### Tasting notes

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Classic Bordeaux-style aromas of cedar and cigar box. Black and red fruit flavours, leather and cigar box notes with some meaty hints, with added pepper and spice from the small percentage of Shiraz in the blend. Velvety smooth and packed with succulent, juicy fruits, with fine-grained tannins to balance and a long length. Impressively rich, yet still elegant.

### About the producer

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In 2003 Laurence Graff OBE acquired the Avontuur estate in Stellenbosch, he set to create one of the leading South African wine estates. From the high-altitude terraces, located on the steep slopes of Botmaskop Mountain and frequently cooled by Atlantic breezes, the estate can count on impeccable grapes that carry the intensity of fruit that is the hallmark of Delaire Graff wines. Under Graff's ownership and the skilled Morné Vrey, Delaire Graff wines have regularly won international and national awards and the estate has become established as one of the best in South Africa.
