### Tasting notes

This is an impressive wine with a lovely approachable pinot nose of concentrated sweet red berries with undertones of ripe blackberries and blackcurrant leaf. The wine is full of energy on the palate with layers of juicy fruit supported by elegant tannins and fresh acidity which give a real sense of the summer. Drink from 2015.

### About the producer

One of the legendary estates in Volnay, Domaine Lafarge has been crafting understated and pure expressions of Pinot Noir for decades. Committed vigneron Michel Lafarge and his son Frederic tend to 11.6 ha of vines in Volnay and Beaune. The range is a dazzling collection of terroir-driven Burgundy's which are incredibly traditional in style. Little new oak is used in the winery allowing the purity of the fruit to shine through, giving wines of exceptional purity, focus and energy.
