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A limpid, deep crimson robe (partridge eye) with violet highlights. Generous, red fruit aromas, plums and cherries, white pepper spice and a touch of wood-smoke. On the palate, a creamy texture of boiled sweets, blackcurrant, again spicy with liquorice and salt. Soft, mature tannins sustaining a well-balanced, lingering finish. A medium to full-bodied wine, marked in particular by the Grenache grape sustaining a soft and ripe texture. For drinking over a 2 to 5 year period.
