## Tasting notes

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Made from 65 year old vines, this wine has bold dark aromas with succulent strawberry fruit notes. The palate is warm and inviting with a velvety structure and very elegant, soft red cherry fruit flavours. Seamless tannins and a refreshing finish balance the sweet fruit. This is delicious and will be sensational in a few years time but will mature for a decade. Drink from 2016.

## About the producer

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Romain Taupenot is one of the rising stars in Burgundy and is the 7th generation, along with his sister Virginie, to continue the family tradition. Romain is a perfectionist who is always striving to achieve the very best and he has transformed his family domaine over the last few years producing increasingly impressive wines. He uses organic methods and focuses on expressing pure fruit flavours which display each terroir. Oak is used judiciously to avoid dominating the wines. Romain's wines are refined and pure, rather than powerful, a style which expresses itself well through his excellent 2011s which are extremely elegant.
