### Tasting notes

Orange zest and rose petals with a touch of spice. Ripe, complex fruit characteristics: Lychee, peach and pink grapefruit. This is astonishingly long with tremendous complexity. Utterly beguiling today with juicy fruit and beautiful perfume but the best is yet to come. The underlying savoury character and earthy minerality of Zotzenberg will be revealed with time and provide a wonderful counterpoint to the overt fruitiness. This is special.

Founded in 1853, Domaine Boeckel is now run by the 5th generation of winemakers, Jean-Daniel and Thomas Boeckel. A true Alsatian gem, the Domaine stretches over 23ha of vineyards now farmed according to organic viticulture. Their pure, mineral and elegant wines are a great way to start exploring the depth and potential of Alsace. From the only vineyard in the world to produce Sylvaner with Grand Cru status, to their concentrated and powerful Rieslings to bewitching Gewürztraminer, there is plenty for any wine aficionado to love.
