### Tasting notes

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A fresh nose of light cherry blossom and a touch of orange peel giving it a real zingy vibrance. The floral and citrus notes carry through on the palate and lead on to an incredibly crisp, slate minerality which lingers on a lengthy finish. This combined with well balanced acidity holds the wine together making it easy to drink and a perfect accompaniment to fish or a light salad.

### About the producer

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Founded in 1853, Domaine Boeckel is now run by the 5th generation of winemakers, Jean-Daniel and Thomas Boeckel. A true Alsatian gem, the Domaine stretches over 23ha of vineyards now farmed according to organic viticulture. Their pure, mineral and elegant wines are a great way to start exploring the depth and potential of Alsace. From the only vineyard in the world to produce Sylvaner with Grand Cru status, to their concentrated and powerful Rieslings to bewitching Gewürztraminer, there is plenty for any wine aficionado to love. Those are wines perfect to experiment with food-wise.
