Tasting notes

The elegant aroma of summer berries, strawberries and rhubarb is held in place and balanced by sophisticated oak. On the palate there is excellent depth; pure, sweet red fruit and spiced notes. The tannins provide precision and grip alongside a backbone of vibrant acidity.

About the producer

Domaine Girard is now run by Alain Girard. The family come from several generations of winemakers in the tiny village of Chaudoux, located a few miles northwest of the town of Sancerre and directly north of Chavignol. The Girards lovingly tend 12 hectares of vines and only the best of their production is bottled under their label. A state of the art cellar with all best the modern technology combined with traditional viticultural practices and minimum intervention in both vineyard and cellar result in a beautifully crafted Sancerre.
