### Tasting notes

The grapes for the Estate Sauvignon have been sourced from three premium wine regions. Aromas of lemon, asparagus and a refreshing salty note from the Olifantsrivier grapes. A rich palate from the lees contact, with mouthfilling citrus and gooseberry fruits with lemon peel, grapefruit and underlying minerality with a tangy salty note on the finish. Crisp acidity to finish.

### About the producer

In 2003 Laurence Graff OBE acquired the Avontuur estate in Stellenbosch, he set to create one of the leading South African wine estates. From the high-altitude terraces, located on the steep slopes of Botmaskop Mountain and frequently cooled by Atlantic breezes, the estate can count on impeccable grapes that carry the intensity of fruit that is the hallmark of Delaire Graff wines. Under Graff's ownership and the skilled Morné Vrey, Delaire Graff wines have regularly won international and national awards and the estate has become established as one of the best in South Africa.
