### Tasting notes

Juicy red berries, wild herbs and fruit compote create an attractive and tempting aroma. The palate is redolent with bright cherry fruit, crunchy redcurrant and layers of exotic spice. Seductive and intense, there is a real elegance here ? combining fresh fruit and a full, velvety texture. This is a wonderful wine that has a brilliant, mineral-inflected finish. Incredibly versatile, this would be a brilliant match for pasta, salami, soft cheese, grilled meats and olives. Enjoyable now or over the next three years.

### About the producer

Musella is set within the beautiful, green hills of San Martino Buon Albergo, near Verona. Its vineyards cover three different hillside locations on south and west-facing slopes, which offer a remarkable differentiation of soil types: the Monte del Drago, Perlar and Palazzina hills. Maddalena Pasqua is the incredibly talented winemaker at the helm of the winery. Her love for nature and deep respect for the soil led her to become one of the most fervent ambassadors of biodynamics in Italy. The result is wines with incredible elegance and focus, brimming with life and tension.
